

RAAF Darwin Golf Club Open 2024 - Conditions of Entry

- 1. The RAAF Darwin Golf Club Open 2024 will be a single stroke event played over 36 holes: 18 holes Saturday 29 June and 18 holes Sunday 30 June 2024
- 2. Entry fee is \$55 which includes a light lunch on Sunday, and must be paid before teeing off for Round One via the RDGC Bar.
- 3. The Open will be under the management and control of the Tournament Committee consisting of the Match Committee of the RAAF Darwin Golf Club. The decision of the Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. The Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event and/or cancel all or any section of this event and reserves the right to alter starting tee times.
- 4. The field will be restricted to 124 players and cut off will be according to handicap if required.
- 5. The event is open to amateurs who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf NT or Golf Clubs registered with such state or overseas associations recognised by Golf NT and who have a current Australian Handicap or recognised overseas handicap.
- 6. Maximum Handicaps: Men 54 Ladies 54. Handicap for the 36 holes is as per Round One. This may alter for the daily event on Sunday.
- 7. Planned Grades: MENS: A 0-12; B 13-18; C 19-54. WOMEN: 0-18; 19-54. These may change, depending on starters handicaps to even-up grades.
- 8. Round 2 will be a seeded draw for the top 4 players by Gross in each grade. Seeded players not playing in their seeded tee time will forfeit major prizes. Round 2 draw will be available on the club website after 8pm Sat 1st July.
- 9. In the event of a tie or ties for OPEN Champions or Grade Champions (Gross) there will be a sudden death playoff commencing at Hole 1 then 18 continuously until a result is reached. Winners for all other ties will be decided by normal AGU/LAGU count backs.
- 10. Players shall report in person to the starter at least 10 minutes before their published starting times and shall start at the time and in the order as per the days draw. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this tournament that if a player arrives at the starting point, ready to play within 5 minutes after the published starting time (in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7), the penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes instead of disqualification.
- 11. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply, together with any Local or Temporary local rules in play on the day.
- 12. Practice on the competition course is not permitted during the tournament or between rounds. Refer to Rule 7-1b. The course will be closed to competitors from 2pm on Friday 28 June.
- 13. All players must enter their completed card into the scoring computer within 15 minutes of completing their round. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 14. Protests must be made to the Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play, except on the final day when they must be made within 5 minutes of the conclusion of play.
- 15. Players may only accept ONE (1) Major Prize.
